AS Both Stadium Fields now have Field Turf Please note the following policy for both Stadiums

Paul Cline Stadium & Cater Family Foundation Field and Locker Room Policies

Turf Fields

- Check the field to be sure it is free of debris prior to, and after your match.
- Prior to the players walking on the turf field, they should make sure their cleats are free of mud and grass.
- Bench areas should be free of all trash and debris following the match. Make sure to place all trash in proper receptacles.
- No food is permitted on the turf field or bench area. This includes candy and sunflower seeds.
- No Gum is allowed on the turf field or bench areas.
- No tents, pop ups, lounge chairs or folding chairs are allowed on the turf field or sidelines.
- Large trash receptacles will be provided beside each bench. Please make sure all trash is picked up after your match.

Locker Rooms

- Locker rooms should be picked up after the match and floors should be free of trash, (pre wrap, tape, water bottles, caps, etc.).
- After the match is over, water coolers are not to be dumped on the field. They should be dumped on the outside of the fence.
- If you are warming up on the grass fields, player's cleats must be free of mud and grass before entering the locker rooms. We will not tolerate cleats being cleaned in the sinks or banged on the walls.
